Four Grants at \$104,000 will be Given to Four Different Austin Nonprofits in June, 2007

(Austin, TX – January 4, 2007) – Impact Austin, a local philanthropic group of women, announces its fourth annual request for grant proposals and will extend four \$104,000 grants to four different Austin-area charities in June, 2007.

"This year, hundreds of local women have pooled individual \$1000 donations to make a significant impact in the community. We have grown from a small group of 4 passionate women to an army of over 400 members in four years," said Rebecca Powers, founder and president of Impact Austin. "I think of Impact Austin as a joyful epidemic that continues to spread! Women are finding their philanthropic voices and using them to make a difference right where they live. With the grants we extend in June, 2007, we will have put over \$1,000,000 to work in the community to benefit local projects."
